In addition, post-production activities are underutilised and pupils often struggle to make meaningful revisions. Teachers need to be more strategic in using post-production activities to address misconceptions. Teachers are working very hard, but impact often remains elusive. Come along and find real solutions to the challenges marking and feedback present.

- High impact marking strategies. Developing feedback in all its forms.
- Improving pupils' ability to respond to feedback and running effective feedback sessions.
- Developing peer and self-assessment and using strategies for encouraging pupil ownership.
